WORKSHOP ON FUTURE FREIGHT POTENTIAL SCENARIOS WAS HELD IN HELSINKI ON THE 13.9.2018

For a good start of the day the cargo potential based on the statistics and interviews was introduced by Reima Helminen and Minna Alhosalo from Brahea Centre at the University of Turku, CMS and Liina Viikberg from Europroject.

Ulla Tapaninen from the City of Helsinki gave us a good view on the insights from the previous projects to the future roro traffic over Gulf of Finland. The Helsinki – Tallinn tunnel project with the Rail Baltica forms a gateway to Europe. Ulla opened up the background information about the estimated cargo volumes and the effects of the different tunnel prices as the passenger demand.

Finnish Transport and Logistics SKAL and The Association of Estonian International Road Carriers ERAA had a joint presentation how both of the associations see the future and its challenges. They shared the view of the future.

After the presentations, all the participants joined the workshop and worked on the issues of the traffic on the Gulf of Finland and the needs and feasibility of the Loviisa – Kunda connection. The summary of the workshop will be published shortly.
